

Dear Scott,

On September 24, 2014 at a regular meeting the FMPO Executive Board approved the following amendments to the FY14-18 TIP Table 6 – Highway Safety Improvement Program. A letter of the same date includes a table showing one project by an earlier name, Zuni/Lone Tree, that has since been corrected and hereby submitted to ADOT for review and approval:

- De-obligate \$133,570 in HSIP funds from f61103 Transverse Pavement Markings project.
- Transfer and re-obligate those funds to the following projects to cover projected costs:
  - \$36,891 to f61201-2 Sign Replacement.
  - \$52,000 to ~~f61401~~ Switzer Canyon Intersection **f61102**
  - \$44,679 to f61105 Beulah Bike Lanes
- Recognize a loan from ADOT in the amount of \$44,679 in FY 15 to be repaid by FMPO in the same year.
