

Phoenix Area Freeway Restrictions:

**Note:** Times listed are subject to change due to rain. Slow down and merge safely in work zones.

**1 I-10 WB closed between the I-17 "Split" interchange near Sky Harbor Airport and Seventh Ave for scheduled maintenance and inspection work. The I-10 WB ramp to I-17 SB ramp at the "Stack" interchange west of 19th Ave also closed. The SR 51 SB and Loop 202 WB (Red Mountain Freeway) ramps to I-10 WB at the "Mini-Stack" interchange closed. Detour:** I-10 WB traffic approaching the closure can detour on I-17 NB starting near Sky Harbor Airport and access I-10 WB at the "Stack" north of Van Buren St. **9 p.m. Fri – 9 a.m. Sun (Sept. 14)**

**2 Loop 101 NB (Pima Freeway) closed between Shea Blvd and Princess Dr/Pima Rd in Scottsdale for widening project. Loop 101 NB on-ramps at Via De Ventura and 90th St also closed. Detours:** Consider alternate routes to avoid delays. Traffic exiting at Shea Blvd can travel west to NB Scottsdale Rd to reach Loop 101. **10 p.m. Fri – 5 a.m. Mon (Sept. 15)**

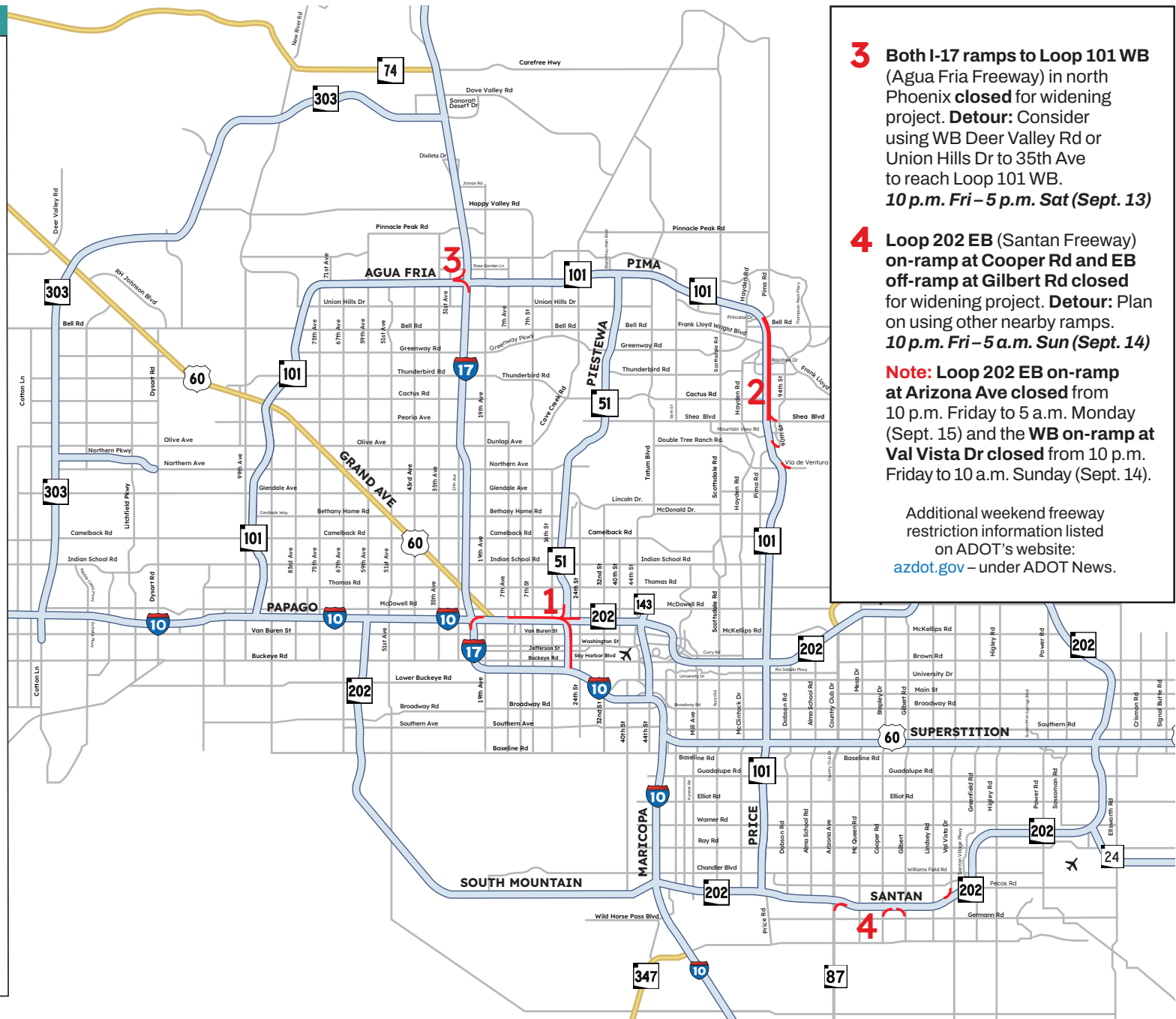
**Note:** Arizona Cardinals fans who normally use Loop 101 NB to travel toward Glendale (Sunday game) should allow extra time and consider other routes including Loop 202 WB (Red Mountain Freeway) to SR 51 NB to reach Loop 101 beyond the closure.

**3 Both I-17 ramps to Loop 101 WB (Agua Fria Freeway) in north Phoenix closed for widening project. Detour:** Consider using WB Deer Valley Rd or Union Hills Dr to 35th Ave to reach Loop 101 WB. **10 p.m. Fri – 5 p.m. Sat (Sept. 13)**

**4 Loop 202 EB (Santan Freeway) on-ramp at Cooper Rd and EB off-ramp at Gilbert Rd closed for widening project. Detour:** Plan on using other nearby ramps. **10 p.m. Fri – 5 a.m. Sun (Sept. 14)**

**Note:** Loop 202 EB on-ramp at Arizona Ave closed from 10 p.m. Friday to 5 a.m. Monday (Sept. 15) and the WB on-ramp at Val Vista Dr closed from 10 p.m. Friday to 10 a.m. Sunday (Sept. 14).
