SUBJECT:

Salary Caps Elimination and New Pre-Award Process

<u>Effective February 14, 2011</u>, the salary caps set per Information Bulletin 07-03 are rescinded to conform with Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) policy, FAR Part 31 and 23 CFR, Chapter 1, §172.7(b) for contracts involving federal funds.

In place of salary caps, ADOT Audit and Analysis (A&A) will review the direct labor rates of all wage classifications submitted on cost proposals for reasonableness in conjunction with its overhead review. To perform its review, A&A will use a methodology based on a historical cost study of three years of direct labor rates paid to prime consultants. This methodology has been reviewed and approved for use by the FHWA.

ECS will determine if direct labor rates proposed by the prime and subconsultants are reasonable based on the historical cost study analysis.

This change will <u>not</u> affect past contracts or any contracts that are currently in negotiations. The change will only affect the contracts that have been selected/awarded <u>on or after</u> February 14, 2011.
