ECS INSURANCE PROGRAM

Effective September 17, 2012, the ADOT Risk Management Office will be responsible for approving and maintaining insurance certificates furnished to the Department for all ECS contracts.

During ECS contract negotiations, Consultants will continue to provide a current Insurance Certificate as part of their eCMS online Cost Proposal submittal. The ADOT Risk Management Office will review the online insurance documents and will advise the Consultant and ECS if insurance requirements are met prior to execution of the contract.

Consultants are responsible for updating or renewing insurance certificates quarterly or annually before they expire. Consultants are also responsible for ensuring their Subconsultants meet insurance requirements. All renewal Insurance Certificates must be directly submitted by e-mail or fax to the ADOT Risk Management Office:
