2020-2021 CONSULTANT PREQUALIFICATION

Please note that all current 2018-2019 Consultant Prequalification Applications with ADOT/ECS are scheduled to expire on December 31, 2019. The 2020-2021 Prequalification period will open November 18, 2019. For the 2020-2021 prequalification period, no information from the 2018-2019 prequalification application will carry forward as firms will start a new application. Firms must be prequalified for the 2020-2021 timeframe in order to submit a Statement of Qualifications (SOQ) for ECS contracts with an SOQ due date on or after November 18, 2019. Consultants are required to submit their 2020-2021 Prequalification Applications online via the electronic Contract Management System (eCMS). Allow seven (7) to ten (10) business days for ECS review and approval of the application. Consultants should plan ahead and allow sufficient time (10 business days) to have the Prequalification Application reviewed and approved by ECS prior to submission of an SOQ proposal.

Subconsultants are not required to be pre-qualified, but are encouraged to do so.

Firms with remote access Mobile Pass can access the online application from the Citrix Access Gateway at <a href="https://remote.azdot.gov/vpn/index.html">https://remote.azdot.gov/vpn/index.html</a>. After logging on to eCMS, click on the Prequalification button on the left navigation to access and complete the eCMS online Prequalification application.

New firms or firms with no remote access Mobile Pass must log on to the ADOT website (<a href="https://apps.azdot.gov/websignon/logon.asp">https://apps.azdot.gov/websignon/logon.asp</a>) and complete a form to request a username and password to access the Prequalification System. After receiving a username and password via e-mail (referred to as a Single Sign-on), the firm must return to the ECS website and use the new Single Sign-on to access and complete the online prequalification application. Allow three business days to receive the Single Sign-on via e-mail.
