

Congratulations, New Driver!

Your Instruction Permit allows driving privileges similar to a Driver License, but with this restriction:

- *Only drive with a licensed driver 21 years or older in the seat beside you.*

6 months after being issued a permit at an MVD office, you can apply to get a Teen Driver License (called a Class G or Graduated License for drivers 16 and 17 years old) if you:

- *Complete the practice requirements*
- *Are at least 16 years old*

Here's how to apply for the Teen Driver License (Class G) when it's time:

1. *Make an appointment for a Road Test*
2. *Gather the right documents (make a list and check it twice)*
3. *Get parent / guardian approvals (by the way, if your parents share legal custody, you need approval from both)*

If you're 18, you're ready for a regular license and don't need parent approval.
