

Congratulations, **New Driver!**

Your Instruction Permit allows driving privileges similar to a Driver License, but with this restriction:

• Only drive with a licensed driver 21 years or older in the seat beside you.

6 months after being issued a permit at an MVD office, you can apply to get a Teen Driver License (called a Class G or Graduated License for drivers 16 and 17 years old) if you:

- Complete the practice requirements
- Are at least 16 years old

Here's how to apply for the Teen Driver License (Class G) when it's time:

- 1. Make an appointment for a Road Test
- 2. Gather the right documents (make a list and check it twice)
- 3. Get parent / guardian approvals (by the way, if your parents share legal custody, you need approval from both)

If you're 18, you're ready for a regular license and don't need parent approval.
