HONORARY FOREIGN CONSUL
PLATE APPLICATION

You must be a citizen or permanent resident of the United States and have been appointed by a foreign country to facilitate and promote the interests of that country with Arizona, as an honorary consul.

To apply for an Honorary Foreign Consul plate, mail this application to the address above. A copy will be returned when the plate is mailed to you. Please keep that copy; it may be required for future actions.

With the application, provide a copy of your current Consular Identification Card issued by the U.S. Department of State in Washington, D.C., which acknowledges your honorary consul status. A copy of the current Consular Identification Card must be on file with MVD, both at the time of original application and the time of the annual renewal of the plate. When you are issued a new identification card, submit a copy of that card to the Special Plates Unit.

In the case of an Emeritus Honorary Consul, proof of emeritus status must be submitted. Acceptable proof is a copy of a current Official Credential card issued by the governor of Arizona, which acknowledges current Emeritus Honorary Consul status, or verification that you are listed as an Emeritus Honorary Consul on the current roster of the Consular Corps of Arizona.

The special plate fee for the initial issue is \$1.52, renewal or transfer of this plate, other fees may apply. A lost, stolen or mutilated plate may be replaced for a \$5.00 fee, plus a postage fee of \$1.52. The fee can be submitted by check or money order, or you may choose to fund your AZ MVD Now account. Use the following link to access or create your account: www.azmvdnow.gov If you choose to fund your account, you may also upload your application and supporting documents. Please email specialplates2@azdot.gov if you fund and upload to your account.

This plate may only be displayed on a vehicle registered or leased in your name. If leased, but not registered in your name, a document showing you as a lessee is required. The plate may not be displayed on a motorcycle or similar type vehicle or a trailer.

You must notify MVD prior to transferring the plate to a newly acquired vehicle, to another vehicle registered or leased in your name, or if you no longer meet the eligibility requirement for the plate. It is unlawful for you to knowingly permit the plate to be displayed on any vehicle that has not been authorized by MVD.

I have read and understand the requirements and restrictions for use of Honorary Foreign Consul plates.
