ARIZONA RESIDENCY AFFIDAVIT

The Arizona Residency Affidavit may be used as one acceptable document for proof of residency. The form is completed by the applicant stating the address where they reside or by a representative or parent/guardian certifying for the applicant.

- Section A - The applicant will complete this section to Self-Certify their Arizona Residential address
Or
Section B - Representative or Parent/Guardian will complete this section on behalf of applicant
o Proof of residency for representative or parent/guardian is required
Travel Credential - This document may be used as one proof of residency and does require one additional proof
o Secondary proof of residency can be any mailed document from MVD
