



ARIZONA TRAVEL DL/ID REQUIREMENTS

The Arizona Travel DL/ID may be accepted by the federal government for official purposes defined as; boarding commercially operated airline flights, entering federal buildings, or gaining access to military bases, or nuclear power plants.

Document Requirements • All must be originals or certified copies, in English, certified by the issuing agency. • Out of state Driver License or Motor Vehicle Record (MVR) expired less than one year, required to waive testing. • DL applicants must meet testing requirements prior to issuance.
