

SCHOOL BUS SKILLS TEST WAIVER REQUEST

Requirements – During the 2 years prior to applying for the school bus endorsement, the applicant has:

- Held a valid Commercial Driver License (CDL) with a P (passenger) endorsement to operate a school bus representative of the group to be driven
- Has not had a driver license or CDL suspended, revoked or canceled, or been disqualified from operating a commercial motor vehicle
- Has not been convicted of any disqualifying offenses listed below while operating a commercial vehicle or of any offense in a noncommercial vehicle that would be disqualifying if committed in a commercial vehicle
- Has not had more than one conviction of any of the serious traffic violations listed below while operating any type of motor vehicle
- Has not had any conviction for a violation of state or local law relating to motor vehicle traffic control (other than a parking violation) arising in connection with any traffic accident
- Has not been convicted of any motor vehicle traffic violation that resulted in a traffic accident
- Has been regularly employed as a school bus driver, has operated a school bus representative of the group the applicant seeks to drive and provides evidence of such employment

Disqualifying Offenses (conviction for any one of the following) as defined in 49 CFR 383.51

- Driving under the influence of alcohol or controlled substance
- Blood alcohol concentration of 0.04 or greater while operating a commercial vehicle
- Refusing to take a blood alcohol test or leaving the scene of an accident
- Using a motor vehicle to commit a felony
- Driving a commercial vehicle with a CDL that has been revoked, suspended, canceled or disqualified
- Causing a fatality through the negligent operation of a commercial vehicle, including but not limited to crimes of motor vehicle manslaughter, homicide by motor vehicle and negligent homicide

Serious Traffic Violations as defined in 49 CFR 383.5

- Excessive speeding, involving any single offense for any speed of 15 miles per hour or more above the limit
- Reckless driving including but not limited to offenses of driving a commercial vehicle in willful or wanton disregard for the safety of persons or property
- Improper or erratic traffic or lane changes, or following too closely
- Violation, involving a fatal accident, relating to motor vehicle traffic control
- Driving a commercial vehicle without a proper license (class or endorsements)
