



# AUTHORIZED PRESENCE EXEMPTION REQUEST

In accordance with Arizona Revised Statutes 41-1080, all individuals applying for a license (including an agency permit, certificate, approval, registration, charter or similar form of authorization) issued by the Motor Vehicle Division for the purposes of operating a business in Arizona, must present documentation indicating that the individual's presence in the United States is authorized under federal law.

I certify that I am exempt from presenting authorized presence documentation because **both** of the following apply:

- I am a citizen of a foreign country or, if at the time of application, I reside in a foreign country, and
- The benefits that are related to the license do not require me to be present in the US in order to receive those benefits.
