

Attached is the MTIP Federal and State Funded Project sheet amendment #1 to reallocate funds as follows:

- **REMOVE TIP #:** CY-DOT-13-22, \$150,000 FY16 funds obligated to SR69 Safety and Capacity
- **ADD TIP #:** CY-DOT-115-26, \$150,000 to FY16 construction of SR89 and Perkinsville Road Roundabout
