We have reviewed your December 2, 2015 request to amend the FY 2016-2019 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) to include the enclosed list of projects approved by the Sun Corridor Metropolitan Planning Organization Executive Board on November 10, 2015.

We accept this Amendment in accordance with 23 CFR 450 and find that this STIP amendment was developed based on a continuing, cooperative and comprehensive transportation planning process in accordance with the 23 USC 134 and Section 5303 of the Federal Transit Act (49 USC 53).
