Yuma Metropolitan Planning Organization (YMPO) is requesting the 2014-2018 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Amendment #13 approved by the YMPO Executive Board on February 23, 2017 be included in the State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). This amendment includes the following changes:

- 1. Adding \$15,583 of regional STBG funding to project COY-TE-08C Fourth Ave Gateway: B-8 from Stateline (MP 0) to complete the FY17 Construction phase of the project:
  - Federal Funding (TA Funds): \$519,437
  - Federal Funding (STBG): \$15,583
  - 5.7% Local Match: \$32340
  - Over Match: \$205,473
  - Total: \$772,833
- 2. Moving the construction phase of Group #1 Bridges-YC-BR-05C (#7751) & YC-BR-06C

(#8865) from FY 18 to FY 19. Funding levels remain the same.

3. Adding \$134,000 of regional STBG funding to project YC-17-01C: North Frontage Road in FY 17

Federal: \$1,101,739Match: \$\$66,595Total: \$1,168,334

4. Adding \$227,550 of regional STBG funding to project SOM-TE-07C: City of Somerton Cesar Chavez Multiuse Pathway

Federal: \$227,550Match: \$13,754Total: \$\$241,304

5. Adding \$480,020 of regional STBG funding to project WEL-14-01C: Town of Wellton Coyote Wash MUP for the FY 19 Construction phase.

Federal: \$972,413Match: \$58,778Total: \$1,031,191
