Phase 2 LPAs: Page, Holbrook, Taylor, Springerville, Eagar, St. Johns, Williams

NACOG is requesting a budget increase to the Phase 2 Sign Procurement project (NAC 16-006D).

NACOG's FY2017-2023 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) currently has the design budget for the Phase 2 Sign Upgrade project (NAC 16-006D) programmed at \$45,000. The original intention for the design of this project was it to be done by ADOT Design Group personnel. However, ADOT Project Management made the decision to have this design done by an outside consultant (due to lack of ADOT staff to complete the design work). TY Lin was selected from the ADOT On-Call list. The firms on the ADOT On-Call list are selected based on qualifications as is typical for professional services. Construction projects and material projects undergo the competitive bidding process.

The new cost for the design phase for the Phase 2 Sign Upgrade project will be \$105,000 (\$85,000 for consultant fees, \$20,000 for ADOT PMDR fees). NACOG proposes to increase the design budget by \$60,000 in FY17 and keep the \$45,000 design budget in FY16 unchanged. The construction budget of \$538,000 in FY17 will remain unchanged. This project will be contractor installed and advertised through ADOT C&S. **Project budget is 100% federally funded – no local match is required.**

NACOG's FY2017-2023 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) currently has the design budget for the Phase 3 Sign Upgrade Project (NAC 16-012D) programmed at \$50,000 and the construction budget (NAC 17-014C) at \$268,000. ADOT Project Management has made the decision to use an outside consultant to design this project. Due to the forecasted increased project costs of this decision, NACOG proposes to increase the design budget to \$125,000 (FY17) and the construction budget to \$290,000 (FY18).
