We have reviewed your January 16, 2018 request to amend the FY 2017-2020 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) to include the enclosed list of projects approved as FY 2018-2022 Transportation Improvement Program Amendment 2 by the Yuma Metropolitan Planning Organization Executive Board on December 14, 2017. Since the FY 2018-2021 STIP has been approved, we are processing this as a pen and ink request to amend the FY 2018-2021 STIP.


