We have reviewed your January 30, 2018 request to amend the FY 2018-2021 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) to include the enclosed tables of projects approved by the Pima Association of Governments Regional Council as Transportation Improvement Program amendment #3 on January 25, 2018.
