Please be advised that we have reviewed the City of Tucson's FTA Grant Application **(1667-2018-2)**. Pima Association of Governments (PAG), as the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the Tucson Metropolitan Area **(UZA ID #40720)**, concurs the project(s), listed in the above referenced grant application, are consistent with the 2018-2022 TIP, approved by the PAG Regional Council on May 25, 2017.

The grant is for \$2,823,535 of FTA 5307 funds for FFY 2017 and \$15,317,340 of FTA 5307 funds for FFY 2018. In addition, the grant includes \$2,033,802 of FTA 5339 funds for FFY 18. The local matching funds will total \$4,632,625.
