Attached is WACOG FY2015 TIP Amendment #4 – Administrative Modification, which WACOG requests ADOT review and process. This administrative modification to WACOG's FY 2016 TIP allocates \$30,620 of STP funding (\$28,875 Federal and \$1,745 Local Match) in FY16 form the BUL13-102C Construction to BUL 13-102D Design

The changes in the WACOG FY 16 TIP are as follows:

- 1. Decreases FY 2016 STP funding for BUL 13-102C (TRACS# SS9940)
 - Decreases Federal Funds from \$2,615,165 to \$2,586,290
 - Decreases Local Match Funds from \$158,075 to \$156,330
- 2. Adds FY 2016 STP funding for BUL 13-102D (TRACS# SS9940)
 - Adds \$28,875 in Federal Funds
 - > Adds \$1,745 in Local Match Funds
