RE: Americans with Disabilities Act Design Standard

ADOT's design standard for roadway projects is the US Department of Transportation ADA Standards for Transportation Facilities {2006}, which is based on ADAAG. All new or updated features are to be designed in compliance with these standards.

The Proposed Accessibility Guidelines for Pedestrian Facilities in the Public Right-of-Way (2011) commonly referred to as PROWAG, is not a standard but should be considered for use when practical.
